Declaration of Loss

I, _____, was the drawer/payee (*circle one of these choices if the item was a certified check*) of the above-described certified check OR the remitter/payee of the above-described cashier's check or teller's check (*circle one of these choices if item was a cashier's check or teller's check*). I understand that if this claim is paid and the check is later presented for payment by a person having the rights of a holder in due course, I am obliged to either refund the payment to the bank if the check is paid or pay the amount of the check to the person having rights of a holder in due course if the check is dishonored.
